


# Girls+ Compose

Girls Compose is a program for high school students who identify as female or non-binary to study music composition. It is structured with 10 weeks of 90-minute classes focused on learning traditional music composition.

The curriculum includes learning music notation software; digital audio workstation software; basic techniques of harmony, melody, structure and form, and orchestration. It will also include analysis of historic and contemporary works. Students will also have their newly composed works performed and recorded in a concert setting at the end of the course.

\*Girls+ Compose is an extension offering of the SHE Festival of Women in Music and aims to provide the tools needed to succeed as a composer.
